

AQHA

Open to registered quarter horses. Exhibitor must be residents of the region and have their own membership card.

Please include copy of AQHA registration papers and exhibitor's current membership card.

AQHA memberships are available at the show office. Proof of residency is required.

Amateur & Youth: Exhibitor or immediate family member must be owner of the horse. Youth may not show a stallion in a Youth class.

Novice Classes: Open to riders with "Novice" denoted on membership card. May not show a stallion.

Junior Horse: Horse five years old or younger. May be shown in snaffle bit or hackamore. No more than two horses may be entered with same exhibitor

Senior Horse: Horse six years of age and older. Must be shown in bridle. No more than two horses may be entered with same exhibitor.

Green Horse: Horses that have not earned more than 10 points or earned \$1000.00 in division.

All Around-Awards: Must enter at least 3 separate categories as stated in the AQHA rulebook to qualify for all-round awards. Halter classes count but not mandatory. Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, and Select may choose to show in Youth or Amateur halter to count towards the respective all around. In the case of competing for two all arounds, the exhibitor must designate which all around the halter points will apply, prior to showing.

NRHA/NRCHA/NCHA/NSBA

All Owners and Riders must be current members.

Memberships and NRHA competition license available at horse show office.

Please refer to the appropriate association handbooks for the specific rules and regulations.

SHOW INFORMATION

Lead Line Class: Riders 6 & Under

Small Fry Classes: Riders 10 & Under

Walk/Jog: Riders entered in this division may not cross enter into a class that requires a lope at same show.

Cattle Classes: Must be pre-entered on entry form. In the case of classes running concurrent, only one cattle fee will apply. Sorry, no cattle refunds.

Trail: Only riders/trainers will be permitted to walk the course in a collective fashion with the course designer and/or judge. There will be a three-minute grace period after the completion of the walk for the first horse to be called on course. Trail schooling - \$10.00 fee for ten minutes.

Entries: Must be complete with copies of registration papers and current memberships.

Stabling: Stalls \$170.00 includes shavings and Tack Room \$130.00. Arrivals accepted on Tuesday, July 20. Day stalls are not available. Please use entry form to reserve stalls, including non- show horses. For horse blocks, stall reservation summary form may be used for multiple reservations. Sorry no stall refunds.

Stall Cleaning Deposit: A mandatory separate check of \$25.00 is required for each stall. Refunded to self-cleaned stalls or forfeit deposit.

Shavings: Self serve bulk shavings available on grounds at no extra charge.

R.V. Parking: Power and water hook-ups are available for \$150 for duration of the show.

Adds & Scratches : Must be completed in the office. Scratches not submitted to the office will not be refunded.

Dogs: Dogs are not allowed in the show arena area.

Refunds: Refunds for entries will be paid in full prior to the post entry date. A Veterinarian Certificate and a \$25.00 cancellation fee will be required for scratches after July 10. Stalls will not be refunded.

Prize money: Prize money will be paid per NRHA/NRCHA/NCHA payback percentages within 30 days of completion of show. Prize money will not be issued to U.S. exhibitors without a reported social security number on entry form.

Directions

From Highway 1

From the east take **232 St. exit**. Proceed **straight** ahead at stop sign, along **72nd Ave. East**

From the West take **232 St. exit North**. After passing over freeway turn **right** at **72nd Ave East**. (1st corner)

Thunderbird Show Park is located at the corner of **72nd Ave. & 248th St.**

Main entrance is on **72nd Ave.**

From the United States

I-5 North through Everett, Mt. Vernon and Bellingham

In Bellingham bear **right** onto ramp to **Meridian St.** [HWY 539]

Bear **right** onto **Meridian St.** [HWY 539]

Continue onto **Guide Meridian Rd.** [HWY 539]

Follow this road to **Canadian Boarder Crossing Aldergrove**

Once through border continue **straight** until you reach **Fraser Highway** (2nd light)

Turn **left** onto **Fraser Highway**



Turn **right** at **248th St.** (traffic light)

Follow 248th St. to **Thunderbird Show Park**
